Thank you for your interest in the North Texas School of Swedish Massage. Prospective students are encouraged to tour the school anytime Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 8 PM. This gives students the opportunity to look around, get a feel for the place and ask questions.

Morning Classes are held from 8 AM to 1 PM Monday through Friday. Evening Classes are held from 6 PM to 10 PM Monday through Friday.

After touring the school, the next step is enrollment. To enroll, first make an appointment with Don Halsell by calling (817) 614-7278. Classes are limited and seats are based on a first enrolled, first reserved basis. Appointments to enroll for any of the above dates are being taken at this time.

There are Two Tuition Payment Options: **Pay As You Go** and **Pay Up Front**. Students who pay for books, tuition and fees **“Up Front” save \$500**.

There are Three Program Lengths: 582 hours, 550 hours and 500 hours. Students who enroll only for the 500 hour program spend **about \$1,000 more** and receive up to 70 **less** supervised clinical experience. Programs are as follows:

500 Hour Program: (Minimum course hours required by state of Texas)

450 Classroom Hours + 50 Internship Hours

550 Hour Program: (This program includes an optional 50 hour internship. These additional internship hours will offer not only additional hands on experience but a \$1,500 price break as well.) 450 Classroom Hours + 50 Internship Hours + 50 Optional Extended Internship Hours

582 Hour Program: (This program includes an additional 12 hours of classroom instruction called Rich Therapeutic Techniques™ or (RTT™). RTT™ is a series of techniques performed in specific order which alleviates pain, immobility and dysfunction, plus an optional 70 hours of clinical experience.) This is the **recommended program** for those who wish to learn a Medical approach to massage or body work, in addition to learning relaxation techniques, and is the only PM program offered.

450 Classroom Hours + 120 Massage Internship Hours + 12 RTT™ Classroom Hours

In an effort to promote professionalism, students are required to wear scrubs or slacks and a shirt with a collar during the internship, and to look professional.

Here students are NOT REQUIRED to purchase a massage table or join any organization. No money is deposited with our school for state testing or licensing but instead those fees are paid directly to the testing service and the state licensing department.

You are invited to visit the school, sit in on a class or purchase massage from either a student or a licensed therapist. You are also welcome to contact any of our graduates and to ask them about their experience here at the North Texas School of Swedish Massage. We do our best to make you feel secure and comfortable.
